<u>Sinterklaas</u>

When you're arriving, it's Sinterklaas in the Netherlands. On 5th December, the Dutch traditionally celebrate Sinterklaas. On the evening of 5 December the children will sing special Sinterklaas songs. Needless to say that all this is organized by the parents, who occasionally even go as far as hiring a person disguised as the mythical bishop to visit their homes.
